Your privacy is important to us

The Banff Registry is a representative of the Government of Alberta. We are committed to protecting the privacy, confidentiality, accuracy and security of the personal information collected, used, retained and disclosed in the course of doing business with you. Only authorized personnel have access to your information and our systems and processes are designed to prevent the loss, misuse, unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction of your personal information. We share your information only as required and in limited instances. We keep your personal information only as long as it is required.

What is considered "personal information"?

"Personal Information" means any information about an identifiable individual. Examples of what we may collect include:

- name, address, email and telephone number
- age, gender, family and marital status
- driving history
- medical and health information
- employment information
